



Applicant Selection Qualifications Turkey

Gallagher Scholar Candidates are citizens of Turkey who reflect academic achievement and evidence of leadership potential. Race, gender, and religion are not considered as factors in scholarship selection. Nine Candidates will be selected to interview with Gallagher Foundation Representatives. Individuals selected as Candidates for the Gallagher Scholarship meet the following criteria:

VALUES

A Gallagher Scholar Candidate shows evidence of a high level of ethical values, which include:

- Belief that progress can be achieved without violence
- Exhibiting strong commitment to making a difference in their country
- Traits which align with the *Gallagher Foundation Traits of Distinguished Leaders*

LEADERSHIP

Gallagher Scholar Candidates display evidence of leadership determination and potential through their involvement in leadership activities including, but not limited to:

- Special projects
- Awards received
- Extracurricular activities
- Service work

ACADEMIC

Gallagher Scholar Candidates must be enrolled in the first semester of their first year at BU. Gallagher Scholar Candidates possess and show evidence of unusual intelligence and ability:

- Passed English Prep with a minimum grade of: C or above
- Major of Choice:
 - Architecture
 - Business
 - Education
 - Engineering
 - History
 - Law
 - Language
 - Math
 - Philosophy
 - Political Science
 - Psychology
 - Science
 - Technology
- GPA: align with requirements for University admission. If selected, in special circumstances, as a 2nd-4th term candidate minimum GPA of 2.5 is required

FINANCIAL

Gallagher Scholar Candidates come from economically disadvantaged backgrounds displaying evidence of financial need:

- Household income - rent (if any) divided by the number of people in the household = less than 1000TL / person
- Consideration is taken for other critical household issues (special health problem, sudden incidents, etc.)
